Dear Warner Community,

Today, the State Board of Education voted in favor of allowing schools to begin providing methods of instruction beginning Monday, April 6th. This will indeed be a learning process for all of us, we will work together to do our best to educationally serve all students in Warner for the remaining 25 school days left on our 2019/2020 school calendar. Our last day of school this year is Monday, May 11, 2020. This has been a great year in Warner Public Schools and we are excited to finish the year STRONG.

Instructional delivery the last 25 days will vary based on a student's ability to be connected digitally. Our teachers have already been working hard to prepare for both digital methods of instructional delivery as well as a paper/pencil "packets" method of instructional delivery. We will meet your student's educational needs over the course of the final five weeks of school.

You do not need to go buy a device or attain internet at this time. If you already have suitable devices and connectivity (by cell service, internet or wifi) using the digital platform is highly encouraged. Much of what we will assign digitally can even be done on a smartphone. Again, if you are not ready for digital learning at home we will provide compatible paper/pencil lessons. The plan for attaining these lessons will be explained in a different letter early next week. In fact, the entire plan for our final 25 days will be clearly explained early next week. Stay tuned.
