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## I. Reading / ELA

### A. Real World Reading & Writing Application - Choose 1 daily

1. If you are a crafty person, make crafts with your kiddos and have them write about it (how-to, description, etc.).
2. Go on a scavenger hunt and write about sights, sounds, etc.
3. Research a topic of choice and present it to your family.
4. Trash to Treasure challenge!! Lots of baking, cooking, eating 'round here...which makes TRASH but also so many teachable moments-recycling, following recipes, cleaning, creative new perspectives
  - a) SAVE your cardboard (cereal boxes, oatmeal containers), plastics ( water bottles, lids, k-cups- y'all know COFFEE is a must, peanut butter jars), and paper (newsprint, colorful labels)!
  - b) DECORATE - (color, paint, cover with foil) your saved items.
  - c) BUILD something, ANYTHING! Robots, cities, monsters, bugs.....FUN
  - d) CLEAN up your messes- recycle when possible

## II. Math/Science

### A. Real World Math & Science Application- Choose 1 daily (Remember your child being able to do the math around them will be so important to them the rest of their life!)

1. Bake with them or just have them look at recipes- this will help with fractions. Show them different measuring units: ounces in pop cans, juice, or water, gallons of milk, measuring cups and spoons, the kitchen has so many opportunities!
2. Measure with a measuring tape, ruler, their hand, whatever you can find. Ask them what would be best to measure how tall they are, the house, their pet, they can measure anything!
3. Any type of cards, dice, or make your own set can be used to multiply, divide, add, subtract, or compare numbers.
4. Teach them how to use and count money. Coins, bills, checks, look in the paper or make up your own numbers for how much they can spend and what they need to get. Have them make change and count money back to you.
