COVID-19 PLAN

DAILY PROTOCOL

1. Parents will follow a self-monitor checklist daily before sending their child to school.
2. Staff will be stationed at every designated entrance with thermometers to check all students entering school. No one will be allowed in with a fever. This includes staff and students.
3. Students will have their temperature taken before they get on the bus. Students will be spread out on the bus. We will expect siblings and family members to sit together.
4. Hand sanitizing stations have been installed in every classroom for student and teacher use.
5. Students who have developed a temperature (99.7 or higher) during the day will be sent home that day plus a minimum of one additional day, until the student is fever free for 24 hours. Students with fever will be required to wear a mask and must be picked up immediately. When students are sent home by the nurse, she will give them a card with a minimum return date.
6. School buildings will be cleaned daily including use of aerosol misters for all solid surface decontamination.
7. Lunchroom- At Elementary, teachers will take names of students who are eating lunch as they go through line. Students will not use the keypad to enter their numbers. At high school, a duty teacher will be assigned to enter the lunch numbers as students go by.

GUIDELINES FOR BEING IN CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WHO HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

If a staff member or student has known close contact with an individual who has tested positive (e.g., someone in their household), they should stay home, self monitor for symptoms and be tested. The individual should not return to the school until they have been tested and/or have completed a 14 day quarantine period.

CURRICULUM

Warner Public School will offer 2 types of education, Traditional and Virtual. Traditional Education is coming to school daily. If virtual education is something you are interested in, please contact your building administrator as soon as possible.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Warner Public Schools believes in the importance of extracurricular activities as part of the traditional school experience. Research suggests that a student's emotional and social well being is often directly correlated with exposure and participation in these activities. Our goal is to keep our students and families safe. Events will be monitored individually.

VISITORS

No visitors allowed at Warner Public School. If a parent needs to pick up a student, they must call the office and we will escort the child to your car. We will not allow outside food during the middle of the day. If lunch is sent, it must be sent first thing in the morning with the student.

MASKS

Wearing a mask will be optional but recommended for students. If a mask is worn, it must be worn properly. If a mask is worn, it must be a solid color mask without graphics.
